




# **Program Overview**

- Applications opened February 1, 2021
  - Eligible projects that incurred expenses on or after November 2, 2020 are eligible to apply retro-actively
    - These projects must be submitted by March 1, 2021
- Incentives of:
  - Up to \$250,000 available per project
  - Up to \$500,000 available per parent company
  - Minimum incentive amount of \$1,000
