
#### **MANDATE**

# **Calls for Proposals**

- Guided by market needs and provincial priorities
- Open and competitive
- Detailed guidelines document
- Applicant webinar
- Two-stage evaluation process
- Fairness monitor oversight
- ~\$0.5-\$10M per project
- 1:1 fund matching

# Partnership Intake Program

**Evaluation of projects referred by <u>Trusted Partners</u>** 

- Ongoing process: no deadline
- Referral basis: not an open solicitation
- Funding per project: \$500k to \$5M\*
- Same 2-stage review process calls
- Program guide on web: eralberta.ca

## **Energy Savings for Business (ESB)**

- Launched Feb 2020
- Up to \$1M for Alberta businesses
- Funding for eligible technologies
- Open to new applications

#### **Expanded Technologies Pilot (ETP)**

- Launched December 2021
- Technologies not supported through ESB
- Open to new applications

#### **Small Producers Energy Efficiency Deployment (SPEED)**

- Launched March 2022
- Expanded eligibility for oil and gas producers
- Application window closed May 2022


