



SEMI Program Overview

PURPOSE

To help industrial and manufacturing facilities improve their energy performance and increase profitability by offering co-funding to implement an integrated system of practices, processes, and capital retrofits.

OBJECTIVES

To support eligible facilities to:

- Understand energy use & reduce related costs
- Optimize energy use & reduce GHG emissions
- Grow organizational skills and capacity building
- Implement energy-saving capital retrofits
- Improve energy performance
- Increase profitability & competitiveness









SEMI Program Overview

The Program is funded by:







Natural Resources Canada Ressources naturelles Canada

Technology Innovation and Emissions Reduction (TIER) fund

SEMI covers up to 50% of eligible project costs for for-profit organizations and up to 100% of eligible project costs for not-for-profits and Indigenous organizations. Allows in-kind contributions from the facility to offset the co-funding requirement for certain activities. Additional funding caps per eligible activity are stated on the SEMI website.

Program ends March 31, 2027









Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ The facility is owned or leased in Alberta and has been in operation for at least one year with fixed equipment and building(s) used to produce goods.
- ✓ The facility operates in the following sectors defined by North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes:
 - 11 Agriculture, forestry, fishing and hunting
 - 21 Mining, quarrying, and oil and gas extraction
 - 22 Utilities
 - 23 Construction
 - 31-32-33 Manufacturing
 - 48 Transportation
 - 56 Administrative and support, waste management and remediation services



Facility Readiness Assessment (FRA)

Review of select process and major equipment

Assessment of current energy management practices and systems

Systematic analysis of energy use, energy balance and energy baseline

Energy Assessments and Audits (EAA)

EAA will:

Target systems that service the entire facility like steam systems, process heat or compressed air systems.



Describe the current equipment, operating conditions, proposed energy efficient alternative, the associated energy savings, and other benefits.



Provide a business case related to the proposed energy saving opportunities with sufficient economic analysis to support business decisions.









Energy Management Information Systems (EMIS)

The FRA contains an initial assessment of the facility's EMIS. EMIS are critical tools within the SEMI framework, providing people with the ability to collect, analyze, and manage energy data to inform operating decisions.

• EMIS include hardware and software components that support:

Data collection & Monitoring

E.g., using sensors and meters.

Analysis & Optimization

E.g., analyzing data to identify inefficiencies, track energy consumption patterns, and optimize processes.

Reporting & Decision making

E.g., providing insights into energy use, which helps in making informed decisions, detecting anomalies, and implementing corrective actions promptly.

Capital Retrofits (CR)

Industrial and manufacturing facilities can receive up to **\$1M** in funding to invest in energy efficiency focused capital retrofits for their facilities after completing the FRA.

The retrofit must meet the following criteria:

The retrofits must be non-emitting.

The retrofits must reduce energy usage and emissions by at least 5% compared to a baseline.

The payback period for the retrofits must be greater than one year.

A new construction is ineligible.









Eligible In-kind Expenses

For for-profit organizations, the SEMI program covers up to 50% of an activity cost; however, it is anticipated that the remaining 50% can be covered in part by "in-kind" contributions.

In-kind contributions are defined as a cost incurred by the Participant that avoids or replaces a task or requirement necessary to conduct an Eligible Activity.



Contractor Eligibility

Any member of the supply chain can be an "Eligible Contractor" provided the company meets the requirements in the Contractor Code of Conduct.

- Installers (Traditional meaning of the word Contractor)
- Manufacturers
- Distributors
- Design, Engineering, and Architectural Firms







(b) Capital retrofits must be certified by an Eligible Contractor that is a licensed professional engineer (P.Eng.) or a Certified Energy Manager or a Certified Engineering Technologist and use standards such as International Performance Measurement and Verification Protocol (IPMVP) to measure and verify the resulting energy savings



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












Contractor User Management


